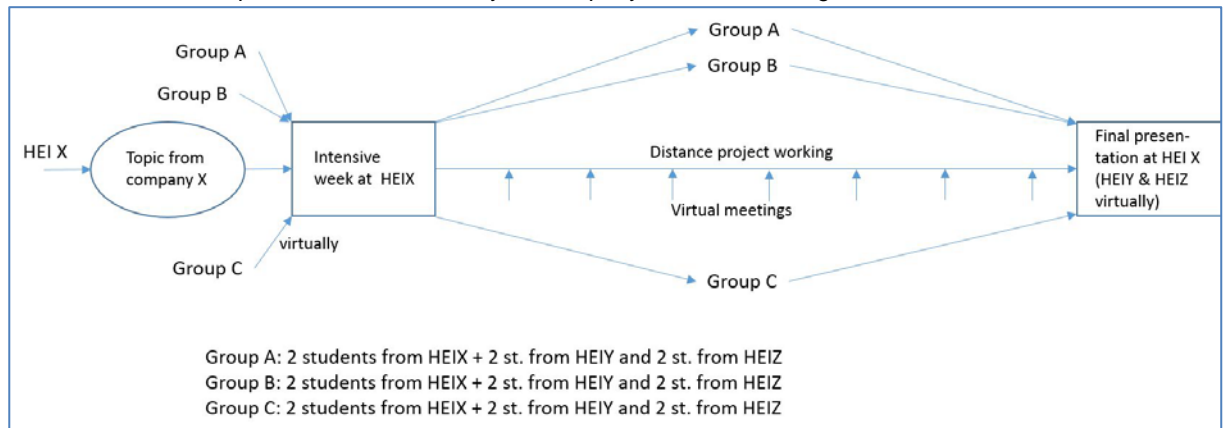

What are we doing in this project?
